

address which I hold in my hand I would, on behalf of those who are directly responsible for its contents, add but one word of protest. The address does not contain one word of empty eulogy, but rather its previous course far short of what the occasion would have justified. To understand the achievements of such a man as Tong King-king, one has first to make an experimental study of the difficulties which obstruct every enterprise in China, and we have only to reflect on the number of big schemes of reform, grandly conceived, and enterprises of great pit and moment whose currents have been turned away, to see how the solid work of the successful pioneer of steam, mining and railroads in this country stands out in conspicuous relief.

These remarks were received with warm approbation by the company, as was the reading of the following ADDRESS.

"We, the undersigned foreign residents of Tientsin, prompted by high appreciation of your personal worth and the eminent services you have rendered to the cause of progress and of friendly intercourse between Chinese and Foreigners, avail ourselves of the auspicious occasion of your completing the cycle of sixty years to offer you our warmest congratulations.

Some of us have known you for many years and in various capacities, while others, having more recently made your acquaintance, know you only as the successful pioneer of steam, mining, and railway enterprise in China. Some of us have had business relations with you, while others are proud to be your friends and to desire to testify to the integrity of your character and the equity of your dealings. It is no small matter for one who has been immersed in business affairs of all kinds, as you have been, for over forty years, to come out of the ordeal without a flaw on his reputation. The standard of commercial honour your example has set up we therefore deem of great value, not only to our countrymen alone, but to all who are engaged in similar pursuits.

It would not be appropriate on this occasion to dwell on that part of your commercial career during which you were acting in a private capacity. It was in the organization of that great national enterprise, the China Merchants' Steam Navigation Company, that your sterling qualities were displayed to the world, and whether regarded as the first introduction of steam on a large scale into this empire, or as the means of enabling the Chinese to gain experience in new and efficient methods of business, the importance of that venture can hardly be over-estimated. Without your energy, capacity, financial reputation, and patriotic spirit, this scheme would in all probability never have been carried out; and it is your name therefore that must ever be associated with that of His Excellency Li Hung-chang as the leader in that new departure.

The honour has also fallen on you of being the pioneer of mining industry in China on foreign principles, whereby a new source of wealth to the country has been opened up which only needs honest and capable management to yield the results in the future. Your colleagues at Kai-ping will be a monument to those who came after you of the triumph over difficulties of a compact and formidable character.

The great problem of the initiation of railway enterprise in the Chinese empire has likewise been solved, to a very great extent, through your untiring industry, and it is to your rare faculty for translating theory into practice that your countrymen will owe this important element of prosperity and strength.

These achievements, significant as they are, are far from exhausting the record of your laborious life. But they are sufficient to entitle you to the respect and gratitude of your countrymen to all future time; and we cannot but think that they fully recognize the claim.

In the establishment and administration of these various works you have employed foreigners of every grade, and you have also had extensive dealings with foreign traders and manufacturers. No one of all those who have thus come in contact with you has failed to be impressed with your business sense, your liberality, and your upright bearing in every transaction, whether of a commercial or personal character. It is our opinion that no single individual has done so much to enhance the good repute of the Chinese throughout the civilized world, and to place on an honourable tone into international business.

No so far as your countrymen have been enriched through your exertions, we rejoice at it, being fully persuaded that only that commerce can be prosperous and successful which benefits both the parties engaged in it.

We wish you may long live to enjoy the respect of your friends and the affection of your family; and when the ordered flow of age overtakes you, may you have the happiness to see the work of your hands growing under the care of men who are wise enough to follow in your footsteps. May Tong King-king's name be a permanent blessing to the whole unexpected demonstration, acknowledged the complacency in a long and most interesting speech in which he imparted to the company some leading biographical details and gave some lucid descriptions of the enterprises in which he had been engaged. His speech was characterized by the simple eloquence of a circumstantial matter-of-fact statement and was cheered to the echo.

Mr. Dering followed soon after and dwelt on the heroism of Mr. Tong King-king's life battle which he commenced without any of the advantages which are generally thought so necessary to success, and he had fought his way to victory by his own force of character. Mr. Dering paid an eloquent tribute to Tong King-king's personal character, his lasting value of what he had done for his country, and there being no stenographer present and the speaker having left Tientsin immediately after the function there has been no opportunity of obtaining an adequate report of his speech.

Mr. Tong Kidon (of Shanghai) supported his uncle in thanking the hosts for their splendid acknowledgment of the services of his uncle, and for the occasion to be received from the Inspector-General of Customs.

The Chairman proposed the health of Mr. Tong King-king's colleagues and staff to whom he had ascribed all the success of his undertakings. This elicited a capital speech from Sheng Tsui, which was admirably rendered into English by Mr. Feng-oh, in which he lauded heartily the eulogues which had been poured in the guest of the evening, and said that Mr. Tong's colleagues, whether in the China Merchants' Co. or elsewhere, could do so to follow in the lines which he had laid down.

Mr. Kinder, Engineer-in-Chief of the Railway, also made a brief acknowledgment and in his turn deprecated any credit being given to himself as Engineer, for what had been accomplished had been the result of the declaration was entirely due to Mr. Tong.

The feast was calculated to last from 7 to 9 p.m. to suit Chinese habits and in reference to Mr. Tong's excellent health, but it was protracted till eleven o'clock, when Mr. Tong retired and everything had gone so pleasantly that there was a feeling of disappointment when the official portion of the banquet was thus suddenly brought to an end.

NOTES FROM NATIVE PAPERS.

Shengho.

Li Han, the Kulan Hui leader who was captured some time ago at Soet'aim and taken to Nanking, has been undergoing severe examinations before the two Hsien and the Prefect. Efforts have been made to extort confessions from him, but the prisoner has kept obstinately silent about his doings although torture has been applied. The Shanghai city magistrate started for Soochow on the 26th inst. His worship's mission to the latter place is connected with some important business with the Governor of Kiangsu.

Hupao.

From the following figures in a report submitted by the gentry of Kuoyao Hsien, Kuangtung, to their magistrate, the number of old people in that district, we cannot help being convinced of the fact that the Chinese are a long-lived race. In that single district there are three persons over one hundred years of age, 180 above the age of 90 and as many as three thousand who have reached the mature age of four-score.

The Nanking authorities have of late been striving their utmost to suppress gambling, and are now determined to do away with this most fascinating of all vices which has been the ruin of so many thousands. The number of families brought to ruin by gambling is incalculable. A successful raid was made one night last week by the Commissioner of Police upon one of the houses that are rented out to students at Examination time and are supposed to be occupied by respectable people. In spite of the imminent career of the house, gambling was carried on within. The capture effected this time is as valuable as it is rare, for all of the captives are men of rank and several of the parties are friends of the Commissioner.

IT WAS MARY SHERLOCK'S WAKE.

"There lays a hundred years of peace and happiness."

It was the wake of Mary Sherlock, who died of old age, and it took place on Thursday, March 19th, 1891, in the City of New York. The room was crowded with men and women, old and young, and aged junkies, who sat on the floor, the military room, said to every new-comer, "There lays a hundred years of peace and happiness," to which the party responded in chorus, "Faith, Mike, never true words did ye speak."

For Grandma Sherlock had come to America from Ireland before any of them, and no doubt, she lived 100 years old when she died her long journey.

But she was one of the old stock, and never knew what illness was. How difficult is such a story as this, for instance, told by a woman!
